100% CAMPAIGN CELEBRATION PLANNED FOR JANUARY 16, 2007 AT OAK VIEW SCHOOL IN HUNTINGTON BEACH

Oak View Elementary School has accomplished a goal this year to ensure that every child has access to health insurance. The 100% Campaign is the first step of a countywide effort to ensure children in Orange County will have the health insurance they need to stay healthy. Both public and private organizations have made the 100% Campaign possible. In addition to St. Joseph's Hospital, Children's Health Initiative of Orange County, Mission Hospital, and Orange County Social Services Agency all played a vital role in bringing the 100% Campaign to Oak View School.

Outreach efforts were provided by bilingual Health Care Access Coordinators from St. Joseph's Hospital and The Children's Health Initiative, who came to Oak View School on Tuesdays and Fridays starting in October 2006, to assist in signing families up for appropriate, affordable health insurance programs.

A celebration event is planned for Tuesday, January 16, 2007, from 10:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., at Oak View School. As Oak View is the first school in Huntington Beach to complete the 100% Campaign for health insurance, this will be a very special event. Ocean View Administration and representatives from the aforementioned organizations have been invited to help the children of Oak View School celebrate this accomplishment.
