- **★** Picking up textbooks (recommend bringing backpack to carry books)
- **★** Having his/her school picture taken and receive an ID card.
- * Purchasing school-related items: PE Clothes, School Pictures, and Yearbook. School Planners will be provided to each student on their first day back to school at no charge. Replacement planners will be at a cost of \$5.00

<u>Note</u>: Students are expected to follow the school dress code while attending Registration Day. Students who do not observe the dress code will not be allowed to have their picture taken during registration.
