The Board of Trustees of the Ocean View School District of Orange County is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) for the implementation of the District's Measure R bond program. After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the District's Board of Trustees appoint a Committee to work with the District. The purpose of the Committee is to inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of bond proceeds of Measure R; review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure R bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure R; and present to the Board, in public session, an annual written report for Measure R. The Committee meets no more than four times per year.
