



FULL DAY PROGRAM CHECKLIST

To receive Full Day state subsidized Child Development Services, families must meet BOTH eligibility and need criteria established by the California Department of Education as stated by the Program Requirements for Child Development Programs. A potential family's eligibility is determined by the family's gross monthly income in relation to family size. Parents and/or guardian's educational training and/or work obligations determine a potential family's need and schedule as it applies to their childcare needs.

1. Eligibility Criteria (Check all that apply below):

In order to be eligible families shall meet **at least one requirement** of the following.

Your family is currently:

an aid recipient, income eligible, homeless; or has children who are recipients of child protective services, or are identified as at risk of being abused, neglected, or exploited.

2. Need Criteria (Check all that apply below):

Need shall be established by the following:

Does your child need full-day services because he/she is a recipient of child protective services, being neglected, abused, or exploited, or at risk of neglect, abuse or exploitation; and/or homeless.

a. Parent A/Guardian: Check all that apply below:

Employed, Seeking employment, In vocational or trade program In an educational program for English language learners or to attain a high school diploma or GED, Seeking permanent housing for family stability; Incapacitated.

b. Parent B/Guardian: Check all that apply below:

Employed, Seeking employment, In vocational or trade program In an educational program for English language learners or to attain a high school diploma or GED, Seeking permanent housing for family stability; Incapacitated.
