We are very excited to transition elementary students back to school **five days a week**, beginning next week. This will be a phased transition by grade level and the schedule is below.

April 12: 2nd and 3rd Grades
April 19: 4th and 5th Grades

*Please note that from May 3rd through the end of the school year, a lunch period and one hour of additional instructional time will be added to all student schedules two days per week.
