### Ocean View School District Provides an Outstanding Education

Since 1874, the Ocean View School District has been providing students in Huntington Beach and portions of Fountain Valley, Westminster, and Midway City with an excellent education.

We are proud to have multiple National Blue Ribbon and Distinguished Schools in our district. Three of our schools have received the prestigious Golden Bell Award from the California School Boards Association and we are home to Lake View STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, & Math) School. Good schools improve the quality of life in our community and protect the value of our homes.



### Essential Repairs and Updates for Our Neighborhood Schools

Most Ocean View School District schools were built more than 50 years ago and need to be upgraded. We need to make essential repairs and improvements so that our schools can serve our students and community well for the decades to come.

Local schools need updates to continue providing students with a 21st-century education – a solid background in science and math, and the skills they need to use today’s technologies and ensure their success in high school, college, and careers. ### Dedicated Local Funding for Student Success

To maintain modern schools and support a first-rate education, the Ocean View School District Board of Trustees has placed a \$169 million bond measure on the November 2016 ballot to update local schools. A potential measure would:

- Repair or replace deteriorating roofs, plumbing, heating, air conditioning, ventilation, and electrical systems where needed
- Provide the infrastructure and educational technology needed to support high quality instruction in science, reading, music, arts, and math
- Improve access to school facilities for students with disabilities
- Improve student safety and campus security systems, including security fencing, security cameras, emergency communications systems, smoke detectors, fire alarms, and sprinklers
- Ensure that children’s playground equipment, campus blacktop play areas, and playing fields meet current health and safety standards

### Local Funding for Local Schools

- Funding could not be taken away by the State or used for other purposes.
- A Citizens’ Oversight Committee and independent audits would be required.
- No funds could be used for teacher or administrator salaries.
- The cost of a measure would be limited to \$30 per \$100,000 in assessed value (not market value) annually or about \$109 per year for the typical homeowner for as long as bonds are outstanding.
