Considerations for Temporary Distance Learning

Key Considerations

The existence of COVID-19 in our nation, state, & especially our region continues to rise & is at a dangerously high rate

Since our last report, California instituted a Regional Stay At Home Order for regions with less than 15% Intensive Care Unit (ICU) capacity

The Southern California Region is currently at 0% ICU capacity

The health, safety, & well-being of our students & staff remain a priority



Considerations for Temporary Distance Learning

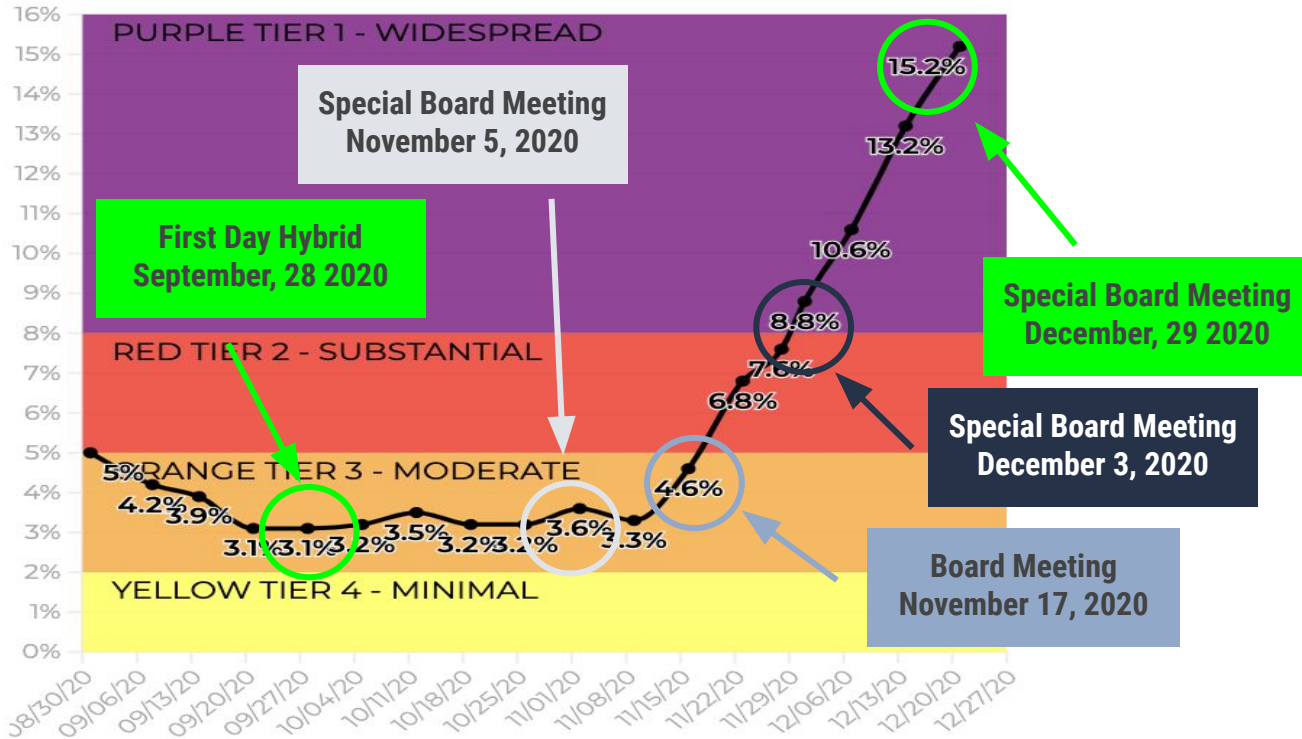
Key Considerations

Changing to Temporary Distance Learning is a local decision, made by the school district's governing board

If a school district has already returned to In-person Instruction, they may temporarily pivot to Distance Learning and then back to In-person Instruction, without the requirement of reaching a certain threshold of COVID-19 statistics

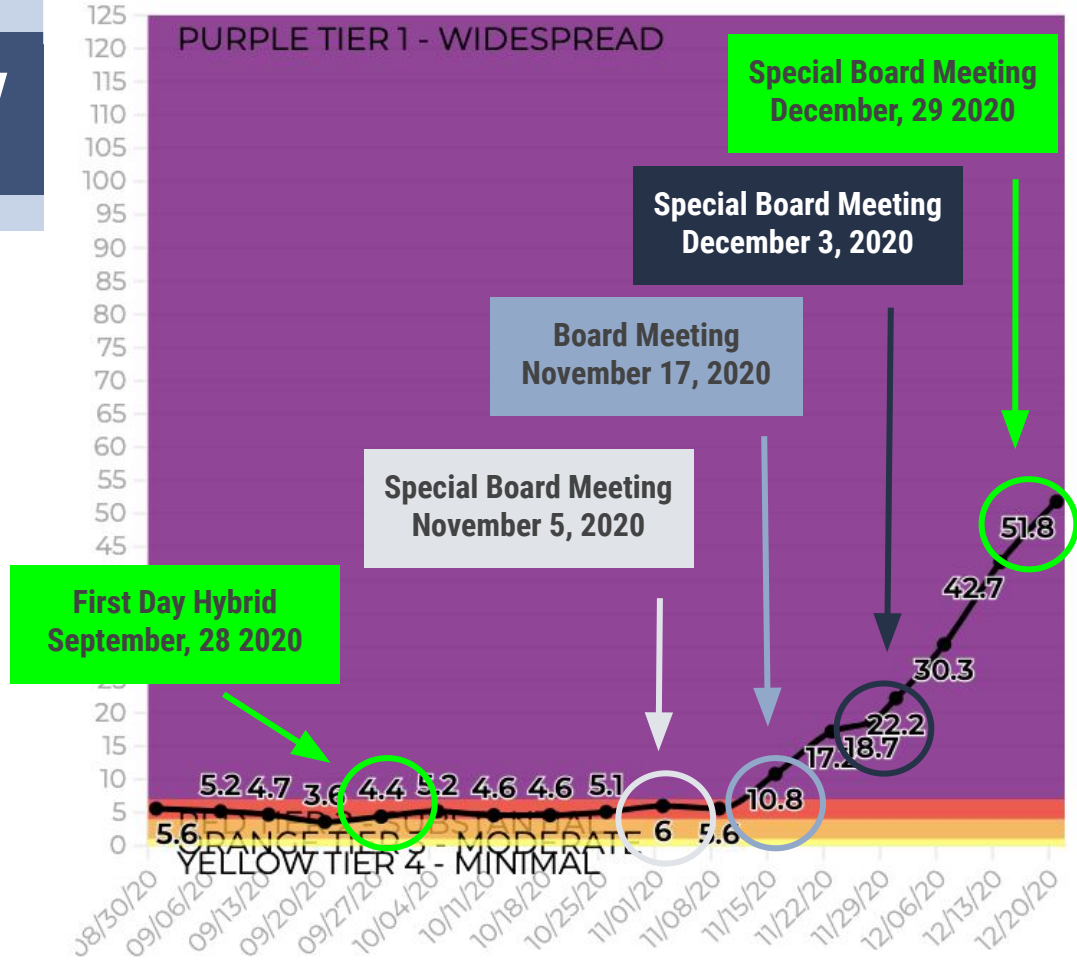


Tier 3
