New Elementary Principals Named for 2018-2019 School Year

Last night, our Board of Trustees approved and welcomed several new elementary school principals for the 2018-2019 school year. These positions will be effective as of July 1, 2018. Our new OVSD Principals are:

Lori Florgan, Golden View Elementary School: Ms. Florgan comes to OVSD from the Capistrano Unified School District, where she currently serves as an elementary Assistant Principal. Previously, she served in the Westminster School District as an English Learner Instructional Support Specialist and Coordinator of Clegg Elementary School's English Learner Program.

Dr. Joy Harris, Harbour View Elementary School: Dr. Harris currently serves as Principal at the James Dukes Elementary School in the Ramona Unified School District. Her background includes a focus on innovative teaching and programs, metacognition, project-based learning, programs for at-risk students, special education, and professional development.

Jennifer Landero, Oak View Elementary School: Among Mrs. Landero's areas of expertise are a 17-year education background in collaborative school leadership, special education, positive behavior management, and community outreach. She currently serves as Spring View's Assistant Principal.

For the 2018-2019 school year, current Sun View Elementary School Principal, Elaine Burney, has been named Principal at College View Elementary School, following the retirement of Katherine Smith.

Construction Update: Oak View Gymnasium/Multi-Purpose Room (MPR)

Our Board was presented with timelines, design layouts, and base bid results for the Oak View Gymnasium/MPR project, which is slated to begin this summer. Taking into consideration total projected costs, de-scoping estimates and Rainbow's settlement contribution, District staff recommended that our Board vote to proceed with the full project as planned, which they did.

Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP): Spring Update to Our Board

Continuing to refine Ocean View's LCAP with comprehensive stakeholder input, Dr. Carol Hansen, Superintendent, and Jodee Brentlinger, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, presented the five goals of our LCAP and asked Board members to provide their input. The first goal relates specifically to strengthening our work in the District's Authentic Literacy approach to core subjects and intervention practices, assessments, and materials. Goal two includes a continued focus on providing professional growth and development opportunities for all OVSD employees. Communication and engagement of students, employees, families, business partners, and our community make up goal three. It includes the District's work to provide communication tools and resources and share clear, transparent communications with our stakeholders. Goal four provides for reinforcing our safety structures and respectful learning environments for all students. Finally, goal five includes continuing to ensure fiscal and capital resources are maximized. LCAP work continues as staff moves toward final adoption in June.

Board Action Taken Regarding Citizens' Oversight Committee Member

Following public comment and Board deliberation, our Board of Trustees voted to remove Gracey Larrea-Van Der Mark from any and all roles and responsibilities from the OVSD's Citizens' Oversight Committee.
