Measure R Construction Update: Interim Housing Plans at Sun View

Dr. Michael Conroy, Deputy Superintendent of Administrative Services, presented our Board with detailed information about the OVSD's Measure R construction plans for Sun View Interim Housing. Starting in the 2018-2019 school year, Sun View will provide a safe learning environment for students and staff whose schools are undergoing Measure R bond modernization (see schedule at www.ovsd.org/MeasureR.) Our Board's Measure R goals and priorities were highlighted at the beginning of the presentation. Board goals include safety, minimal disruption and efficiency. Dr. Conroy then shared our DSA plans for Sun View interim housing construction, which begins this month and continues through the summer. Initial work includes temporary safety fencing around the construction areas and delivery of portable buildings. It is anticipated that staff from Westmont Elementary School, which will be our first school to undergo Measure R bond modernization during the 2018-2019 school year, will be able to enter the revamped Sun View campus in mid-August 2018. Mr. Morgan, who brings full-year woodworking classes to Spring View, is receiving the 2018 Julianna McGrath Award, which honors those who champion arts in the classroom and across various curricula. All award recipients will be honored at Segerstrom Center for the Arts on May 9.



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
