## Board of Trustees Votes to Pursue Multiple Security Measures for All Ocean View Campuses

### Measure R Update: Board Approves Direction, Scope for Multiple Security Measures

During this Measure R Update, Deputy Superintendent Michael Conroy, Ed.D., summarized security measures for all campuses in the Ocean View School District, beginning with a new visitor registration system for each school office. The Raptor Visitor Management system would provide reliable, instant screening using a visitor's driver license or passport. All visitors would be checked against registered sex offender databases in all 50 states. Dr. Conroy also discussed an emergency mass notification system - Activate. This notification system follows the implementation of our new Districtwide phone system earlier this year. It provides a single point of activation during an emergency, using a wide variety of alerts, live updates, and email/text notifications. Finally, Dr. Conroy briefed our Board on a security management system to improve physical access to campuses, in addition to our recently adopted safety fencing plans. ### 2017-2020 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) Public Hearing Held

Ocean View's LCAP supports our District's laser-like focus on achievement for all students. Capping off a year-long LCAP development process with our Board of Trustees and 16 stakeholder engagement events, Assistant Superintendent Jodee Brentlinger presented a brief overview of the final LCAP document prior to the public hearing. The presentation included LCAP highlights: a strategic and intentional focus on student learning, professional learning, strengthened school climates, and innovative programs. ### Board Presented with 2018-2019 Preliminary Budget Report

As we approach the end of the annual budget cycle, Dr. Michael Conroy presented Ocean View's preliminary 2018-2019 Budget to our Board of Trustees, which will come back for final approval on June 21, 2018. Components of the draft budget include general information, assumptions, General Fund revenue, General Fund expenses, General Fund balance summary, and encroachment. Using the 2018-2019 Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), Ocean View assumes an updated COLA at 3.00%, declining ADA of approximately 189 students, increased STRS and PERS District contributions, and health and welfare increases. Dr. Conroy noted that we will continue to work toward a healthy reserve while still facing challenges from increased District responsibility for retirement funding.
