9. Significant Irreversible Changes Due to the Proposed Project

Section 15126.2(c) of the CEQA Guidelines requires that an environmental impact report (EIR) describe any significant irreversible environmental changes that would be caused by the proposed project should it be implemented. In the case of the Proposed Project, implementation would involve construction activities that entail the commitment of nonrenewable and/or slowly renewable energy resources, including gasoline, diesel fuel, natural gas, and electricity; human resources; and natural resources such as lumber and other forest products, sand and gravel, asphalt, steel, lead, other metals, and water. The interim housing improvements would be temporary and would not result in irreversible changes that require long-term soils and public services commitments or nonrenewable and/or slowly renewable energy resources during long-term implementation.
