Board Approves Leadership Contracts, Gives Superintendent Hansen 'Outstanding' Rating

At the August 14, 2018, Board meeting, the employment contracts for Superintendent Dr. Carol Hansen, Deputy Superintendent Dr. Michael Conroy, and Assistant Superintendent Felix Avila were approved by our Board of Trustees and extended through June 30, 2021. President Souders also shared that the Board has experienced the positive benefit of longevity in the leadership of the District under Dr. Hansen. Since 2005, the longest tenure of the District's previous superintendents was 2.5 school years. The Board is so pleased with the work of Dr. Hansen and her team of deputy and assistant superintendents, and has developed longevity clauses for their employment agreements to encourage them to remain in the District for extended years.

Each year, the Board engages in a performance-based annual evaluation of the Superintendent. At the end of each of the past three school years, the Board has rated Dr. Hansen's overall work as outstanding. This year, Dr. Hansen was cited for providing strong leadership focused on all students, rigorous and innovative instruction, and support for all staff members. "The Board is very pleased with the stability and focused leadership that Dr. Hansen and her team have brought to the District," said Board President Jack Souders. Dr. Hansen was quick to attribute the accomplishments of her time in the District to the collaboration that has been established between her administration with the Board and the staff members of the District. "None of this would have been possible without the dedicated work of our classified staff, school principals, and their teaching and non-teaching staff members," said Dr. Hansen. "We are working as a team in the Ocean View School District, with a clear focus on instruction and what is best for students." Board Votes to Approve New Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services

Our Board of Trustees and Superintendent Carol Hansen proudly announced the appointment of Julianne Hoefer, Ph.D., to the District's leadership team. Beginning August 20, Dr. Hoefer will serve as Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services. In her new role, she will oversee the Educational Services Division, including the Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment; Special Education; Child Development Programs; and Student Services Departments. Her appointment concludes a competitive selection process held this summer after Mrs. Jodee Brentlinger announced her appointment as Superintendent of Solana Beach School District in North San Diego County. Dr. Hoefer most recently worked in the Fountain Valley School District as Director of Educational Services and was chosen as the 2017 Curriculum and Instruction California Administrator of the Year by the Association of California School Administrators (ACSA).
