Citizens' Oversight Committee Member Approved for Taxpayer Organization Category

Ms. Diana Lee Carey was approved to fill the vacant position on the Measure R Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC). As part of the passage of our school facilities bond, Measure R, our Board appointed 10 members to its first COC, which included the following categories: business representative, senior citizen group(s), taxpayer organization member, parent/guardian of child enrolled in OVSD, parent/guardian of child enrolled in OVSD and active in parent group, and at-large community member. Ms. Carey fills the role of taxpayer organization member through her membership in the Orange County Taxpayers' Association.

Board Votes to Certify 2017-2018 Unaudited Actuals, OVSD's Final Year-End Closing

Our Board of Trustees voted to certify the 2017-2018 Unaudited Actuals report, which is the annual statement of all receipts and expenditures of the school district for the previous school year. Dr. Michael Conroy, Deputy Superintendent, shared that this final report reflects an increase, or improvement, of more than \$3 million from the Estimated Actuals to the Ending Fund Balance. These funds are now reflected in the 2018-2019 Adjusted Budget. The Unaudited Actuals report will be filed with the Orange County Department of Education.
