OVSD Connections is an opportunity for staff to present our Board with a highlighted overview of District and school programs. The Dashboard, the accountability component of California's Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) law, was created to give the public a better idea of what is happening in our schools. For some priority areas identified in LCFF law, the State Board of Education requires local data to address local indicators.
