Independent Auditor Presents OVSD Board with Annual Financial Audit Report

The independent auditor for OVSD, Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co., LLP, presented the Board members with its annual financial audit report, which included the regular financial audit report and Building Fund Measure R report. VTD Partner and Certified Public Accountant Auditor Royce Townsend advised there were no audit findings related to the District's Annual Financial Report ending June 30, 2018, nor were there any findings related to the financial and performance audits for the Building Fund Measure R report.

OVSD Connections: Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) Process Overview

Dr. Julianne Hoefler, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, highlighted some of the increased opportunities for stakeholder input as part of the LCAP process. She described the LCAP, a three-year plan based on eight state priorities. It includes goals for improved or increased student services and a focus on student achievement and outcomes. With diversity and equity in mind, OVSD is considering a variety of opportunities for input, including surveys for parents/guardians and students, as well as expanded employee involvement. An LCAP Leadership Team is being created to include Board members, site administrators, District staff, parents/guardians, and our union leaders. At this time, LCAP input and ideas are being sought for the 2019-2020 process, while the current year's LCAP process is well under way. Construction Update: Briefings on Multitude of Modernization & Miscellaneous Projects in OVSD

Dr. Michael Conroy, Deputy Superintendent, briefed Board members on various modernization and construction projects in OVSD. He discussed the completion of the Interim Campus, which Westmont students and staff are currently attending for the 2018-2019 school year, while Measure R modernization is completed at the Westmont campus for fall 2019. He provided status reports on the Oak View gym/MPR, the District's central kitchen, fencing at Phase I schools (Harbour, Hope, Village, Golden, Circle, and Lake View Elementary Schools), and other site projects. Future Measure R projects at College View and Marine View were presented. College View staff and families are preparing for their move to the Interim Campus for the 2019-2020 school year. Construction begins in August 2019. The first middle school to be modernized will be Marine View during the 2020-2021 school year. [View the detailed Construction Update.](#)
