### Local Control & Accountability Plan Nears Completion

OVSD's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a three-year plan inviting comprehensive stakeholder engagement from employees, unions, students, parents, and various groups. ### Board Passes Spring View Middle School HVAC Resolution

The Board approved an emergency resolution that enables the District to enter into a contract for services related to a new Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) mechanical system for Spring View to be completed by fall 2019. The HVAC system, approximately 50 years old, has been experiencing frequent systemic failures. A special meeting was held on April 25 at which the Board voted unanimously to support the resolution and requested that staff prepare an HVAC Units Status Report to be presented to the Board in September 2019, and annually thereafter.

### Letter of Support for Assembly Bill 1505 - Charter School Authorization - Passes

Board members approved a District Letter of Support for Assembly Bill 1505 Related to Charter Schools, which will be sent to the State Assembly Education Committee Chair by Dr. Carol Hansen, Superintendent. The letter supports AB 1505, which takes reasonable steps to strengthen the charter petition review, approval, and appeal process, and it recognizes and honors local control of locally-elected school boards, as they represent their educational community.
