#### Instructional Aides

Reviewed requirements and aide responsibility: to provide support in content areas, document & administer the ELPAC, work with small groups of EL students, maintain confidentiality, etc. In addition, the committee discussed aide professional development and training that was provided such as Zoom, & Google training, foundations skills, student engagement strategies, Thinking Maps, and OVSD Signature Practices.
