## Marine View Performing Arts

Principal Sara Schaible, teacher Karen Sanford, VAPA Guild President Charles Mariano, and student Landon Mariano gave the Board an update, along with a video, on Marine View's stellar Performing Arts program. They discussed challenges as well as many highlights they experienced this year. Mr. Mariano stated that the VAPA Guild is striving to establish Marine View as the premiere middle school to attend for visual and performing arts in OC. A Virtual Concert will be held this spring and they are looking forward to moving into their newly modernized school next year.

## In-Person Instruction Delivery Update

Dr. Carol Hansen, Superintendent, provided the Board with an update on the plan to bring elementary students back to school five days a week. She shared that COVID-19 rates continue to fall and OVSD has only one case among students and staff at this time. The CDC and CDPH decreased social distancing requirements for schools to three feet, but layers of mitigation strategies, like mask wearing, are still important in keeping staff and students safe. We have updated our 2020-2021 Instructional Delivery and Protection Plan to align with the most current federal and state safety guidelines. [View the updated plan here.](#)

## LCAP Presentation

Dr. Julianne Hoefer, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, provided the Board with an update on the Local Control & Accountability Plan (LCAP) and process. In-line with stakeholder input, Dr. Hoefer reported that OVSD will continue to focus on three broad goals: Pupil Outcomes & Conditions of Learning, Targeted Supports, and Engagement. ## Star View Modernization

Dr. Michael Conroy, Deputy Superintendent, presented the modernization schematic layout for Star View. The plans include modernized classrooms, a renovated school office building, a new school office, an outdoor covered amphitheater, a new shade structure, a media center and flexible lab, and a new parking lot. ## Elimination/Reduction of Classified Positions

The District is reducing the work year and/or work hours of 24 classified positions due to lack of work and/or lack of funds. The positions being reduced are six child care program facilitator positions, seven child care attendant positions, and 11 bus driver positions (four are currently vacant). Due to lack of work and/or lack of funds, the District is eliminating 17 classified positions (five positions are currently vacant) including: three child care program facilitator positions, two child care attendant positions, two early learning associate educators positions, two early learning instructional assistant positions, four instructional assistant positions, and four instructional assistant-bilingual positions. The reductions and eliminations are part of OVSD's Fiscal Stabilization Plan and will provide an estimated cost savings of \$700,000.
