May Revise Budget Update

Dr. Michael Conroy, Deputy Superintendent, provided a budget update with new figures following the Governor's May Revise. The good news is that California is looking at the largest public education funding in history and COLA is increasing. However, much of the new funding is one time money and does not take into account issues impacting individual districts, e.g., declining enrollment, staffing, pension plans, etc. STRS and PERS contributions will increase \$2.2 million over the next three years, unemployment insurance will increase \$716,000 next year, and there are about 20 one-time proposals of significant importance to OVSD in the May Revise.
