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Marine View's ASB Leadership class is a year-long course where students act as role models and serve the school. The following will give you an idea of what the Leadership class is about as well as the expectations for the class.

**Expectations:**

There will be no toleration for teasing, bullying, or putting down of others. If these issues come up there will be consequences.

3. To help raise money for the activities of the MVMS ASB and spend the funds to benefit all students at MVMS.
4. To attend and actively participate in all Leadership activities.
5. To complete school/community service outside of class.
6. To be a leader that does not lie, cheat, or steal, nor tolerate those who do (in any way).
7. To maintain a 3.00 GPA (and no Ds, Fs, Ns, or Us)

**Failure to maintain any items above will result in probationary status or removal from Leadership.**

**Grading Policy:**

Advisor Evaluations 50%

Advisor will complete individual evaluations based on a rubric. Evaluations will be completed at the end of each quarter. Evaluations will be conducted on events/projects that each group/committee was in charge of as well during the quarter.

Participation/Committee Work/Events/Projects 30%

Daily participation, class assignments, projects, reflections on activities, committee participation, participation in all spirit days/dress up days, and working/volunteering at school functions, plus following the Marine View school rules.

Community service 20%

Each ASB Leader will need to complete Community Service hours (outside of school hours) to help our school and community. Each ASB Leader must complete a minimum of 20 hours per semester (exact number of required hours will be provided in class). A log will be provided so that students can keep track of their Community Service hours.
